DEFINITIONS & GENERAL RULES:

SHOW DATE: _

- 1. Helmets All Youth riders must wear a helmet whenever mounted on property.
- 2. Warm-up Only walking is permitted outside the warm-up ring. Ring etiquette must be used within the warm-up ring.
- 3. Leadline Classes are open to Riders aged 3 to 12 as of January 1st 2023. Leaders must be capable handlers 12 years of age or older. If under 18, they must wear a helmet in the ring. Riders entering Leadline classes are <u>NOT</u> eligible for other performance classes.
- **4. Youth** Class is open to Riders under the age of 18 as of January 1st of the current calendar year. *Youth Games* competitors may show in *Open Games* classes as well.
- 5. Walk/Jog Class is open to all Riders aged 3 to 12 as of January 1st 2023 <u>AND/OR</u> Riders of any age who are within their first year of competition. <u>Loping will NOT be requested or permitted.</u> Horse/Rider combinations competing in *Walk/Jog* are <u>NOT</u> eligible for other Mounted Western classes (they may enter *Showmanship* classes). Riders may compete in other classes/divisions on an alternate Horse.
- **6. Open –** Class is open to Riders of any age who are NOT participating in *Leadline* or *Walk/*Jog.
- 7. Points Will be accumulated by number towards year-end awards.
- 8. **Numbers** Are assigned per Horse/Rider combination. If a Rider chooses to compete on multiple Mounts, a new number will be assigned to each new combination and points tracked accordingly.

^{*} A WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL RIDER EACH SEASON. IN THE CASE OF A CHILD, THE WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED BY A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.
